

Boris, a foreign student at Communication University of China, often shares his experiences of Chinese culture on his v log(视频博客).

In one video, for example, Boris shared how he had learned the Chinese word "dong xi". He translated each part separately into "east west". And he introduced theory(说法) about how "dong xi" came to mean "things". He told people that all marketplaces in ancient Chinese cities were set up along a single road that ran from cast to west. So when you would say "qumaidongxi", you'd be saying, "I'm going to buy things."

Some other videos show his reading Chinese poems and performing kung fu in Chinese traditional costume, which are quite welcome among his 40,000 followers.

"Many of my followers are learning Chinese," Boris said. "But sadly, they know little about Chinese culture and the country."

Like many foreigners, Boris once believed that all Chinese could perform kung fu, flying on to roofs and walking over walls. He thought the country was not that developed. But after he got a scholarship (奖学金) to study in China in 2019, his view changed. "China has entered a new period, but many people's impressions of China are s fill stuck in the 1970s," Boris said. "That's why I started to shoot v logs to share Chinese culture in 2019."

Until now, Boris has posted more than 40 Chinese culture vlogs online. But making these vlogs is not easy. Take reading the poem Second Farewell to Cambridge by Xu Zhimo as an example. "I can understand and read every word in the poem," Boris said. "But to touch readers, I need to use proper feelings while reading."So he needed to look for much background information and make his feelings suit each part of the poem.

Though shooting these v logs takes lots of time, the young man feels proud that his vlogs have inspired many people. Boris said that he wanted to continue bridging the differences between two cultures. "This goal may not be achieved easily, but I will spare no efforts to do my part."



Some people love going to museums, while others really hate it and would rather stay at home, enjoying their favourite TV shows. So museums are being seen as outdated and boring by today's young people. I have just returned to the UK after travelling around the USA. While I was there, I visited lots of museums. However, it was also inter sting to read the stories of those who survived the Holocaust, as well as those who helped others.

Last but not least, I also found the 9/11 Memorial and Museum to be of great interest. This museum is for those who lost their lives, as well as their families, when the Twin Towers in New York City were attacked by terrorists (恐怖分子) in 2001. It tells you how the terrorists planned the attack and what happened as a result of their actions. Surviving pieces of the towers are shown in the museum. It was a truly meaningful visit, which made me value my own life that little bit more.

I think museums play an important role in realizing historical importance for future people. Whatever your interests, there may be a museum for you. You can visit waxwork(蜡像) museums to see models of famous people(and get photos with the Queen!), science museums for an interactive visit and so much more! Best of all, if you're ever in the UK, many of them are free!
