As a child, Huang Rongbing would watch his mother, Weng Xiuzhen, comb her long and thick hair. After forming a bun at the back of her head, she would decorate it with colourful flowers, the 34-year-old man recalled.



(1) All the women in the small fishing village of Xunpu in Quanzhou, Fujian province, decorated their hair this way. The colorful and unique (独一无二的) headdress is known as zanhuan or zanhuawei. It was listed as a national intangible cultural heritage (非物质文化遗产) in 2008.

As an old saying in Xunpu goes, “put flowers in your hair in this life and you will also be pretty in the afterlife.”

2. In 2016, he and his older sister opened a salon where tourists could get their hair styled in the Xunpu tradition and have their photos taken. “We have been fully booked and now there are over 200 businesses offering services to dress tourists with a zanhua,” said Huang.

(3) After going through the full zanhua experience, Hu Titi, one of Huang's customers, even brought zanhua culture to Paris in France last year. Under the Eiffel Tower, she shot photos and videos of herself dressed in traditional Chinese clothes with a zanhua in her hair.

(4) The increase in tourist visits has pleased Huang not only because it is good for his business but also because it has led to greater awareness of the history and culture behind zanhua headwear.

“Earning a big name for their hard work, resilience (坚韧) and compassion (同情心), the women of Xunpu are well-known for harvesting the highest quality seafood,” said Huang. “When they put a zanhua on their heads, they express their wish to look for happiness. The flowers are seen as a symbol of hope.” he added.

Nature was Chen Rui’s “childhood home”. The 37-year-old researcher at the Chinese Academy of Sciences’ Institute of Zoology was not able to talk until he was 4 years old because of the way his brain processes sensor (感官) information.

This made him “strange” in some people’s minds. So, he didn’t have friends who were around his age, which led him to turn his attention to nonhuman things around him. He became enraptured by the world of insects. “The happiest time of my childhood was in the farm fields,” says Chen. “I squatted there, observing the actions of insects. I had so many questions about their activities and was full of curiosity about this world.” These experiences planted a seed in his heart.

Many years later, he’s an expert in life-science research. He has visited the Amazon rainforest several times, and has found around 100 new species (物种), many of which are named after him.

“I was a child who was ‘cured (治愈)’ by nature,” he says. “I wanted to grow up to share the power of nature with more young people and to popularize understanding of animals, including insects. I wanted to start classes to bring children to learn in the open air and experience the gifts nature gives.” These led him to recently publish the popular science book, *Du Chong Ji (Reading About Insects)*.

“Insects were the earliest creatures that could fly and feed themselves by farming. They have survived three mass extinctions (大规模灭绝). No other living things have won such victories.” He hopes that people will learn and draw inspiration from the “superpowers” of insects and use it to improve their own lives.

A great deal of creativity we find in Dunhuang goes through a thousand-year period. Dunhuang culture should be protected because of its great influence.

Once being a main stop on the ancient Silk Road, Dunhuang, is art dated back to 1, 650 years ago. Its Mogao Grottoes are home to more than 2, 000 colored sculptures and 45, 000 square meters of murals（壁画）.

The painting style of the murals changed over the years, giving insight into life throughout the centuries. In addition to their artistic value, today the Dunhuang murals are widely considered as a treasure house with valuable information about culture and social life in ancient China.

Besides the achievement in visual art, Dunhuang is a witness（见证）to the mixture of different cultures. Some faces of these figures have rich shades to produce a 3D impression, a technique common in India and Western countries. The cultural exchanges between China and the West brought peace and also helped Dunhuang culture develop better.

The culture of Dunhuang develops quickly in a remote desert. What's more, it can also make our life more colorful. For example, last year, students from Dunhuang Middle School designed their school exercises based on the local flying Apsara dance, which was inspired by the Dunhuang murals.
